Keeping in mind the aforesaid issues relating to children in North East, NE Cell was created in the Commission on 1.12.2011 for the promotion and protection of child rights in all the 8 States of North East. Under Section 13(1) of the Commissions for Protection of Child Rights(CPCR) Act, 2005, NCPCR has inter alia, and is mandated to examine and review the safeguards provided by or under any law for the time being in force for the protection of Child Rights and recommend measures for their effective implementation.

It is imperative to look at the whole issue of welfare of children from the right perspective and specifically work out ways and means to check the abhorrent crime. Hence, a Consultation on Child Rights in the States of North East is proposed to gain some kind of an understanding of the situation of children and implementation of various Child Rights Acts. The primary purpose of the proposed Consultation is to assess the gaps and challenges in implementation of the Child Rights Acts and way forward action plan thereof.

### 3. Objectives of the Consultation

1. To introduce North East Cell to North East State officials for further coordination.
2. To assess the current situation of Child Rights in the States, programmes, legislations, judicial innervations at the State and district levels etc.
3. To analyze dimensions of violence against children in the States of North East India.
4. To identify the gaps and challenges in the implementation of Child Rights Acts such as POCSO Act, 2012, JJ Act, 2015, etc.
5. To bring all the stakeholders together and come up with recommendations.
6. Delay in data on Implementation of JJ Act, 2015 and POCSO Act, 2012.
