## NOTICE

As per Rules 115(1), 115(2), & 115(7) of C.M.V. Rules, 1989, it is mandatory that every vehicle should obtain PUC Certificate once in six months. In order to ensure that adequate facilities for emission testing of vehicles are available in all the Sub-Divisions of the State, applications in plain paper in the prescribed format are invited from individual / group/ agencies etc. who are permanently residing in Tripura, for opening of new Pollution testing centres in the following Sub-Divisions:-

- 1) Dhalai District: - Longtorai Valley, Kamalpur, Ambassa and Gandacherra Sub-Division.
- 2) Unokoti District: - Kailasahar Sub-Division.
- 3) North District: - Kanchanpur and Panisagar Sub-Division.
- 4) Khowai District: - Khowai Sub-Division.
- 5) West Tripura District: - Jirania Sub-Division.
- 6) Shipahijala District: - Bishramganj and Jampuijala, Sonamura Sub-Division.
- 7) Gomati District: - Amarpur and Karbook Sub-Division.
- 8) Belonia District: - Belonia and Sabroom Sub-Division.

1. The application should be accompanied with a deposit at call of Rs. 500.00 (Rupees Five Hundred) which is refundable.

**Terms and conditions for setting up Smoke Emission Testing Centre in Tripura**

The selected entrepreneurs (agency) will utilize approved smoke meters/gas analyzers with computer linked printouts and issue PUC Certificates if vehicular emissions are within the prescribed limits as provided under Rule 115 of CMVR-1989.

2. The Exhaust Testing Centre will also issue a sticker to this effect at its own cost, which can be displayed on the wind screen/ reverse of Rear view Mirror of the vehicle. The sticker should clearly indicate the validity of the said certification.

3. The validity of the PUC certificates issued by the agency will be six months from the date of issue.

4. The Centre would employ required number of persons to carry out such tests.

5. The entrepreneur would take necessary care of the machines so that machines aren't damaged and are always in working condition.

6. Necessary infrastructure including power connection would be arranged by the agency on a continuous basis duly factoring alternative provisions for load shedding hours.

7. After testing the vehicles the Centre would issue PUC Certificate and a sticker if the vehicle is found fit. If unfit, a letter would be issued to the vehicle owner with a copy to Transport Department giving 15 days time frame for rectifying the defects and to come again to the Centre for obtaining PUC Certificate.

8. An amount of Rs.50.00 will be charged for each Motor vehicle (Three wheeler/TMN/Medium and Heavy vehicle) and Rs.25.00 for each two wheeler tested. This is subject to change from time to time and the centre will necessarily follow the rates fixed by Transport Department.

9. The agency would pay appropriate monthly remuneration to the members working on the project and in no case below the minimum wages for that category of skilled/unskilled workers employed. A canteen to this effect will be maintained.

10. The agency would maintain a separate register providing the details of the vehicles tested and the amount of fee charged. A cash book should be maintained in which the amount of fee collected each month by the entrepreneur will be recorded.

11. The agency would submit a report to the DFO (P) each month containing the details of the vehicles tested and the amount of fee charged. The report should be submitted in the form prescribed by the Government of Tripura.
